Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request for Information – NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board.

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 13 January 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

Please confirm which staff perform the assessment. For example, a midwife or a doctor?

Is it a specialist midwife or a junior doctor at the Newborn and Infant Physical Examination (NIPE) assessment?

Does your trust provide a tongue tie service? If yes please state what this consists of eg outpatient/day case clinic and how many staff and their job designation/band. If No – do staff advise parents to speak to their GP or Health visitor?

What improvements have been made offering parents support on tongue tie in the past 18 months as a result of patient feedback?

Please provide an example and include the source of the original feedback eg National Maternity Survey, Complaint, PALS, FFT.

Does your trust have Baby Friendly Initiative (UNICEF and WHO accreditation)?
