<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 15 May 2024 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the five local authorities of Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Following the response issued for FOI ICB763, I was just wondering if you are able to provide the expenditure for the last financial year for the services which are activity based? It's the services in County Durham and North Cumbria.

Our Response

We can confirm, as per section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB does hold the information requested as follows:

County Durham place

Please find below the indicative values for the County Durham pharmacy services – these contracts are zero based activity contracts.

- Palliative Care Drugs: £500 annual retainer can be claimed, and pharmacies can reclaim costs of out-of-date stock.
- Anti-Viral Drugs: £150 annual retainer can be claimed, and pharmacies can reclaim costs of out-of-date stock.
