<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 31 October 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Your Request

The total value the ICB has been invoiced by care homes between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2023, as well as a) the total value of those invoices the ICB paid within 30 days, and b) the total value of those invoices the ICB paid after 90 days.

Our Response

<u>For Northumberland, North Tyneside, South Tyneside & Sunderland – payments are made by the Local Authorities as follows -</u>

- Northumberland County Council
- North Tyneside Council
- South Tyneside Council
- City of Sunderland Council

<u>For Tees, Durham, Newcastle, Gateshead, and Cumbria – payments are usually made in the following 2 ways either by the ICB or Local Authorities -</u>

1) We pay using an agreed monthly payment schedule based on data using the Broadcare system which captures individual client package information. As information is

updated, any due payments are paid on the next available monthly payment run and not by invoice.

- 2) The local authorities below pay the care homes and recharge the ICB therefore we do not hold the information requested for these payments. Local authorities are:
 - Redcar & Cleveland Council
 - Middlesbrough Council
 - Hartlepool Council
 - Stockton-on-Tees Council
 - Durham County Council
 - City of Newcastle Council
 - Gateshead Council
 - Cumbria County Council
