## <u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 30 June 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

## **Your Request**

I am contacting you on behalf of **Fertility Network UK**. We provide free and impartial support, advice, information and understanding for anyone affected by fertility issues and we are keen to ensure that our services are reaching the right people at the right time. We believe that your Integrated Care Board could play a part in helping us to achieve this.

We're always working to ensure that we are providing the most accurate support and information for our service users and wondered if you could provide us with your <u>current Fertility Policy</u> and any relevant information regarding funding and access to treatments in your area? If this is currently under review, please could you inform us of the consultation dates and timeline for any changes. We're aware some ICBs are still operating using former CCG policies, if this is the case please let me know.
