- 3. Is the specialist weight management service consultant-led? If so, please specify the medical speciality of the consultant(s) leading the service.
- 4. Does the specialist weight management service include remote delivery options (such as virtual consultations, telephone appointments, or digital support platforms)?
- 5. Please provide a copy of the full service specification for the specialist weight management service that you commission, if one exists.
