<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North</u> <u>Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 18 July 2024 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the five local authorities of Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Your Request

Current Beds

- 1. In your ICB area:
 - a. How many CAMHS Tier 4 beds are commissioned? Please give figures for each year from 2020 2024.
 - b. How many CAMHS patients were admitted informally to Tier 4 beds? Please give figures for each year from 2020 2024
 - c. How many CAMHS patients living have been placed out of area^[1]? Please give figures for each year from 2020 2024.
 - d. How many CAMHS patients have been admitted to an adult psychiatric ward? Please give figures for each year from 2020 2024.
 - e. How many CAMHS patients have been admitted to a physical health ward due to a lack of availability of a Tier 4 bed in your provider collaborative area? Please give figures for each year from 2020 2024 and specify whether the bed was an adult or child physical health ward.

- 4. Have any Mental Health Act assessments, where it has been determined that the child needs compulsory detention, been overridden by access assessments in your ICB? Please give figures for each year from 2020 2024.

On this occasion it is not possible to provide the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm the ICB does not hold any of the information requested as NENC does not commission Tier 4 beds.
