<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and</u> <u>North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 18 August 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

- 5. What are you currently using to manage regional bed capacity?
- 6. What is the contract end date of the above system?
- 7. What was the contract value for the above system?
- 8. Are you planning on going out to tender, or review alternative systems within the next 12 months?
- 9. Do you currently have, or are feeding into a CDR (Central Data Repository) or Shared Care Record?
- 10. If so, what is it called?
- 11. If no, are you planning to in the next 12 months?

Our Response

NENC ICB is not able to respond to questions 1 to 4. A request for clarification was sent to you on 21 August 2023. However, we had not received a response by the deadline of 1 September 2023 as per the email sent, so have now closed this part of the request.

NENC ICB is not able to respond to questions 5 to 8. Two requests for clarification were sent to you on 1 September and 5 September 2023. However, we had not received a response by the later deadline of 11 September 2023, so have now closed this part of the request.
