## <u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 05 July 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

## **Your Request**

Please send me the following information from your NHS Standard Contract for Termination of Pregnancy:

- 1. What is the current contract end date?
- 2. When did your organisation, or predecessor organisation(s), last tender (put out to procurement) its Termination of Pregnancy (abortion) services?
- 3. If the contract for these services has been renewed without re-tendering, how many times has it been renewed and when was the last time?
- 4. Are there any plans currently under development or in place to tender for this service? (Please supply minutes/notes of any relevant meetings or decision-making processes, policies etc.)

- 5. How do you envisage Integrated Care Systems affecting how you commission termination of pregnancy services?
- 6. How much do you currently pay for Termination of Pregnancy procedures?
- 7. Who is the current provider/s for termination of pregnancy services?
- 8. What is the current annual contract value?
- 9. Who is the current commissioning manager (name and email address)?

## **Our Response**

- 1) 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024 for all TOPS contracts. TOPS provision is included in the main Foundation Trust contracts renewed annually as part of the overall contract.
- 2) 2016 for Newcastle, Gateshead, North Tyneside, Sunderland, South Tyneside, and County Durham

2022 for Tees Valley

North Cumbria is an associate to the North West provider contracts per Q7 below. North Cumbria including its predecessor organisation has not gone out to procurement directly for TOP.

- 3) Renewed without re-tendering twice, most recently 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 for all areas.
- 4) No decision has been agreed to date to go out to tender. However, the ICB has conducted market engagement during June 2023. <u>NECS466 Termination of Pregnancy Service (TOPS) for and on behalf of NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board Contracts Finder</u>
- 5) This question does not fall within the scope of the FOIA because it is a request for opinion.
