Background

New NHS Pharmacy Contraception Service (PCS)

Women can now get the contraceptive pill directly from their local pharmacy. There's no need to book an appointment with a GP or visit a sexual health clinic.

Pharmacists can also carry out the yearly pill check-up, making it easier for women to keep getting their prescription.

The service gives women more choice and flexibility when starting or continuing the pill. It also helps free up GP appointments for people who need more complex care.

Get the contraceptive pill straight from your local pharmacy

Women in the North East and North Cumbria can now get the contraceptive pill straight from their local pharmacy, without needing a GP appointment.

The new service offers women more choice about where and how they access the contraception.

All pharmacies offer walk-in appointments, with no need to book in advance, and consultations are carried out in private with a trained pharmacist. Pharmacists can help whether someone is starting the pill for the first time or continuing an existing prescription.

A yearly check-up will take place, usually when returning for the next supply.

The service is free and confidential for everyone, including those under 16. Personal information will not be shared unless there is a serious concern for safety or wellbeing.

Contraceptive pill now available directly from local pharmacies

Women in the North East and North Cumbria can now get the contraceptive pill directly from their local pharmacy, without needing a GP appointment.

Pharmacies can already treat simple urine infections for women, and now they can offer the contraceptive pill too – whether someone is starting it for the first time or continuing with their regular prescription.

The service is free and confidential and offers more choice about where and how to access contraception, making it quicker and more convenient while also helping GP surgeries, and sexual health clinics, by freeing up appointments for those with more complex needs.



A short check-up will still be needed once a year, which will take place at the pharmacy when the next supply is collected. If any unusual side effects occur and do not go away, it is important to speak to a pharmacist or GP straight away.

The service is available to all women, including those under 16. Personal details will only be shared with parents or carers if there are serious safety concerns.
