<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and</u> <u>North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 16 November 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Your Request

Under my right to access information under the Freedom of Information Act I request that you provide me with a complete breakdown of the birth statistics for North Cumbria Integrated Trust over the past year, including the numbers of home births, inductions, assisted deliveries and caesarean sections.

In processing this request, I would like to receive the following information in electronic format, preferably in a spreadsheet or PDF document:

- 1. The total number of births that occurred within North Cumbria Integrated Care Trust during the period of January 1, 2023, to date.
- 2. A monthly breakdown of the number of births at North Cumbria Integrated Care Trust, specifying the number of births for each month within the specified date range.
- 3. Births each month categorized by the delivery method (e.g., vaginal birth, caesarean section), the respective number of births for each method.
- 4. The number of births each month involving any form of induction.
- 5. The number of births each month categorized by delivery location (e.g. delivery suite, MLU, home, BBA)

Please provide the requested information for each respective category separately, ensuring that the data encompasses the specific time frames indicated above. If any of the requested information is not available, I kindly request that you provide an explanation as to why it cannot be provided.

If there are any fees associated with this request, please inform me in advance.

I would prefer to receive the requested information electronically via email. However, if this is not feasible, please let me know the alternative methods available for obtaining the information.

I look forward to your timely response within the 20 working days specified by the Freedom of Information Act. Should you need any further clarification or have any queries regarding this request, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Our Response
