<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and</u> <u>North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 13/12/23 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland, and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

- 1. Does your ICB commission Tier 3 weight management services?
- 2. If yes:
 - a. In the last financial year how much did your ICB spend on Tier 3 weight management services?
 - b. Which provider(s) is commissioned to provide the Tier 3 services?
 - c. How many patients are your Tier 3 services commissioned to provide care for?
 - d. Are your Tier 3 services face-to-face only, or do you commission a digital-only weight management service?
- 3. If no, what plans do you have in place to commission Tier 3 services for 2024/25?

4. Who in your organisation would be responsible for the commissioning of weight management services and/or diabetes? Please provide name, position, and contact details where possible.

- 2. Please see below:
 - a. **County Durham:** This service is provided by County Durham and Darlington NHS FT (CDDFT). Expenditure is part of a block payment. This is included within the block contract arrangement; total value is not disaggregated, and no specific service line is available.

Gateshead: This is provided by Oviva for 2022/23 as part of a non-recurring contract. The contract term is 10 months 8 days, and the value is £425,000.

Newcastle: This service is provided by Newcastle-upon-Tyne Hospitals NHS FT (NuTH); expenditure is part of a block payment. This is included within the block contract arrangement; total value is not disaggregated, and no specific service line is available.

North Cumbria: £300k. Block arrangement. The block value is included within the overall block for all services provided to the ICB by North Cumbria Integrated Care NHS FT (NCIC). Tier 3 block was calculated from actual costs of service provision. Overall NCIC block contract includes all acute and community services commissioned by the ICB from NCIC.

North Tyneside: Northumbria Healthcare NHS FT (NHCFT) provide Tier 3 weight management service for North Tyneside patients. This is included within the block contract arrangement; total value is not disaggregated, and no specific service line is available.

Northumberland: Northumbria Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust (NHCFT) provide Tier 3 weight management service for Northumberland patients. This is included within the block contract arrangement; total value is not disaggregated, and no specific service line is available.

South Tyneside: The provider of a Specialist Tier 3 Weight Management Service is South Tyneside and Sunderland NHS FT (STSFT) for South

Tyneside sub-ICB place. There is a block arrangement is place. 22/23 expenditure was £66,873 based on NHS payment scheme.

Sunderland: The provider of a Specialist Tier 3 Weight Management Service is South Tyneside and Sunderland NHS FT for Sunderland sub-ICB place. The service is not commissioned to provide a specific number of places, patients are referred by GPs into the service. 22/23 expenditure was £251,612.

Tees Valley: South Tees Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (STHFT) provides Tier 3 weight management service for Tees Valley patients and covers Middlesbrough, Redcar, Hartlepool and Stockton. There is a block contract arrangement in place. 22/23 expenditure was £502,812.
