Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 26 November 2024 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the five local authorities of Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Your Request

I am writing to make a formal request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I would like to request the following information from the ICB. Please provide:

- The number of virtual ward supplier contracts active in the trust.
- The name of the supplier.
- The length of contract and termination/renewal date of the contracts.
- The award value if publicly available.
- The number of Virtual Ward Beds Contracted and Target.
- The number of virtual ward patients admitted and discharged against the individual contracts from 1 January 2024 to 1 July 2024, broken down by clinical specialty.
- Information on the type of monitoring specified (Intermittent/Continuous).

Timeframe: Active at any time in Calendar 2024.

Information format: If possible, I would like the requested information to be provided in an electronic format, such as a CSV or .xlsx. I understand that this may not always be possible, and I am open to receiving the information in an alternative format if required.

Our Response

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB holds some of the information you have requested.
