## <u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and</u> <u>North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 11 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

## Your Request

I would like to request the following information under Freedom of Information Act and will be grateful for your help.

- Does your ICB have a policy regarding abuse, violence or aggression towards primary care staff by patients? Can you verify if this document (link below) is the latest policy on this issue for your ICB? If this is not correct, can you please provide a copy or link to the correct latest policy for this? <u>https://northeastnorthcumbria.nhs.uk/media/w1ja54hy/icbp041-violence-aggressionabuse-management-policy-2.pdf</u>
- 2. Does your ICB have a policy regarding stalking and harassment (i.e. repeated intrusions) of primary care staff by patients? If so, please could you provide a copy or link to it?
- 3. Does your ICB have a policy regarding primary care staff who experience domestic abuse? If so, please could you provide a copy or link to it?

## **Our Response**

The HR policies described are in place within the ICB and are relevant to ICB employees only. Primary Care providers contracted by the ICB are separate organisations and

therefore will each have their own HR policies relevant to the primary care staff whom they employ.

The North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) does not hold the records which you have sought around primary care staff. However, we have determined the records may be held by Primary Care organisations within the North East and North Cumbria region.

In accordance with our duty under s.16 of the FOIA to provide reasonable advice and assistance to an individual requesting information, we have identified that due to the nature of the information you are seeking, your request would be appropriately addressed to the NENC Primary Care Networks (PCNs). A list of PCNs was made publicly available in our response to FOI request ICB411.
