<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North</u> <u>Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 24 July 2024 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the five local authorities of Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

I am seeking information about your health system. To better understand your digital infrastructure, including your capabilities and degree of integration, can you please tell me:

- 1. Are your data systems between primary, community, and secondary care integrated, and if not, do you have plans to integrate them?

- 3. Do you have a public facing digital strategy?
- 4. Do you use patient-initiated follow-up (PIFU) processes or technology?
- 5. Do you employ the following roles in your health system? If yes, approximately how many?

 - Director of Digital Products
 - Director of Analytics
 - Digital Lead/Director
 - Director of Partnerships
