<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request for Information – NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board.</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 20/01/2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Response:

Please be advised that some localities (referred to as 'place') within the NENC ICB cannot provide the requested information. This is in accordance with section 1 of the Act, as the information is not held by the ICB. Where the information cannot be provided, suggestions have been provided as to what organisation may hold the data.

For question 2 "specialities" some localities consider that this information is exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Section 21 (Information reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means), which provides an exemption from the duty to disclose information which is accessible to the Applicant by other means. This information is already available in the public domain and can be accessed at via the CQC website. Links to the pages of each individual organisation have been provided.

For question 2 "contact names" NHS NENC ICB does hold this information. The ICB however considers the names requested exempt under *Freedom of Information Act 2000 Section 40(2)* (personal information) as it relates to personal information. The ICB follows guidance issued by the Information Commissioner's Office on the disclosure of personal data including direct contact details.

The reason section 1 may not have been applied to the whole request is due to the integration between the disbanded Clinical Commissioning Groups and the inception of the Integrated Care Board from the 1st of July 2022, whereby integration is still taking place across the services and therefore, some localities have access to the information and in other areas it is held by either local authorities or provider organisations.
