Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 15/01/24 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland, and Stockton-on-Tees).

# **County Durham:**

Referrals should only be made following confirmation that the primary care Cow's Milk Protein Allergy (CMPA) guidelines have been followed, which are a subspecialty of paediatric allergy services.

#### Sunderland:

- 1. South Tyneside and Sunderland NHS Foundation Trust provide a general paediatric allergy service which includes cow's milk allergies.
