## <u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and</u> <u>North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 22 March 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

- 1. A copy of the latest correspondence stating the expected numbers and waiting times for patients who are referred to secondary care to receive their first appointment; or,
- 2. A copy of any emails stating the expected number and waiting times for patients who are referred to secondary care to receive their first appointment.

Please provide the information in the form that is most convenient to the ICB.

If it is not possible to provide the information requested due to the information exceeding the cost of compliance limits identified in Section 12, please provide advice and assistance, under the Section 16 obligations of the Act, as to how I can refine my request.
