<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North</u> <u>Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received on 1 May 2025 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley.

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Your Request

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) to request information from your organisation about the provision of weight loss services.

- 4. What is the local child population eligible for tier 3/4 weight loss services? (E.g. Estimated number of children with BMI of 35 kg/m2 or more plus 1 or more comorbidities, or with a BMI of 40 kg/m2 or more with or without comorbidities)
- 5. How many adults did you / do you plan to provide tier 3/4 weight loss services to in the financial year:
 - 2023/4

- 2025/6
- 6. How many children did you / do you plan to provide tier 3/4 weight loss services to in the financial year:
 - 2023/4
 - 2024/5
 - 2025/6

Our Response

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB holds some of the information you have requested.

- 1. NENC ICB provides tier 3 weight loss services for both adults and children.
- 2. NENC ICB provides tier 4 weight loss services for adults. NENC ICB does not provide tier 4 weight loss services for children.

- 4. Please refer to the attached CYP Health Care Needs Assessment document.
