Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)

Thank you for your request received on 9 December 2025 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley.

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Your Request

Please could we request the below information through the Freedom of information process.

1. For each contract, if more than one is managed, when does the current Non-Emergency Patient Transport Service (NEPTS) expire?
2. Have you used the extension(s) available within each contract? If so, are there any remaining extension periods that can be used and when will the contract then end? Please advise for each contract.
3. Who is your main NEPTS provider for each contract?
4. Do you fund any other NEPTS providers within the ICS, including Acute Trust direct contracts with private ambulance services (PAS)?
5. What was the FY 24/25 contract value for each of the primary NEPTS provider contact?
6. What is the current 25/26 contract value for each of the primary NEPTS provider contact?
7. What was the annual total activity for Financial Year 24/25 by mobility for each of your primary NEPTS provider?
8. What is the FY 25/26 contract value for each of the ICS PAS NEPTS providers?
9. What is the current 25/26 contract value for each of the ICS PAS NEPTS providers?
10. What was the annual total activity for Financial Year 24/25 by mobility for each of the ICS PAS NEPTS providers?

11. Did your primary NEPTS provider achieve their contractual KPIs consistently in FY24/25 for each contract?
12. Have they met them consistently in Q1 & Q2 of FY25/26 for each contract?
13. Does the existing contract and commissioning intentions for the NEPTS re-procurement meet the criteria for the Provider Selection Regime Direct Award C for each contract?
14. When is the ICB planning on publishing their intentions, either through market engagement for a procurement, or direct award notice for each contract?
15. What was the FY24/25 value of your secure mental health transport spend across the ICS?
16. Do you have a primary contract for your secure mental health transport, if so, who is the provider?
17. If you do not have a primary contract with a secure mental health transport provider, how do you select the provider(s)?
18. Does the ICB intend to commission a secure mental health transport provider to close a commissioning gap under the new cluster ICB, if so, what is the expected timeline for this?
19. Who is responsible within the ICB for secure mental health transport?

Our Response

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB holds some of the information you have requested.

1. Contracts and expiration dates:
 - North East Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust (NEAS) Core PTS contract is expected to expire 31 March 2027 with the option to extend for a further 2 years.
 - North East Ambulance Sunderland discharge PTS is expected to expire 31 August 2026
 - EMED – Sunderland discharge PTS (day and night vehicle) is expected to expire 31 March 2026.
2. The only contract with an extension is North East Ambulance Core PTS; please refer to the response to question 1 above for the details.

4. We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB on this occasion is not able to provide the requested information.
