## <u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 30 January 2025 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the five local authorities of Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

## **Your Request**

I am requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I am researching GP prescribing expenditure and understand that your ICB holds more up-to-date data than what is publicly available. I would be grateful if you could please provide the following data for GP prescribing expenditure within your ICB:

- 1. Planned year-to-date expenditure (£m)
- 2. Actual year-to-date expenditure (£m)
- 3. Planned budget for the full financial year (£m)
- 4. Forecast expenditure for the full financial year (£m)

## For example:

1. Planned YTD expenditure: £95m

2. Actual YTD expenditure: £98m

3. Planned annual budget: £160m

4. Forecast annual expenditure: £165m

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For clarity, I am specifically requesting data for the General Medical Practice primary care prescribing budget, i.e., the costs of prescribing by those employed in General Medical Practice - GPs, practice nurses, and clinical pharmacists.

If it is not possible to separate the above from other categories of expenditure, please indicate which additional categories are included when you provide the figures.

Please provide the data in Microsoft Excel format. If any clarification is required, please don't hesitate to ask. I look forward to your response within the statutory timeframe.

## **Our Response**

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB does hold the information requested.

Actual YTD expenditure: £445,378,623
Planned annual budget: £580,382,107
Forecast annual expenditure: £601,238,010

Please note, the 2024/25 year-to-date position is as at month 9 (December 2024).
