## <u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received on 4 September 2025 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley.

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

## **Your Request**

I am writing to request the below information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

- 1. Which trusts has the North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board commissioned to provide fracture clinics?
- 2. Which trusts have the North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board commissioned to provide fracture liaison services?
- 3. When did the North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board's fracture liaison service open (month/year)?

## **Our Response**

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB holds some of the information you have requested.

- 2. NENC ICB has commissioned the trusts listed in the response to question 1 to provide fracture liaison services.
- 3. The fracture liaison services opened in the following years:
  - North Cumbria Integrated Care NHS FT: late 1990s
  - Northumbria Healthcare NHS FT (North Tyneside Integrated Musculoskeletal Service): 1 April 2024
  - Newcastle-upon-Tyne Hospitals NHS FT (Fracture clinic, Newcastle): 1999
  - Gateshead Health NHS Foundation Trust: February 2014
  - South Tyneside and Sunderland NHS FT: 2014
  - South Tees Hospital NHS FT: 2010

Please note, that NENC ICB did not come into being until July 2022, so we do not hold all the information you have requested for fracture liaison services opening before this date.

In accordance with the Information Commissioner's directive on the disclosure of information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 your request will form part of our disclosure log.
