<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 16 November 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley (which covers the 5 councils that make it up – Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Your Request

I am writing to submit a formal Freedom of Information (FOI) request regarding periocular and facial surgical funding policies for patients with thyroid eye disease (TED) or facial nerve palsies (FNP) within your organisation.

I kindly request access to any available information related to the funding policies concerning periocular surgical procedures such as brow lift, blepharoplasty, upper eyelid weights and botulinum toxin injections for the aforementioned medical conditions.

Specifically, I am interested in understanding whether you have specific funding policies for patients with TED or FNP, and/or whether they are exempt from needing to meet criteria or follow the individual funding requests in place for patients without these conditions.

Although I recognise that such patients may also undergo other surgical procedures such as facial suspension/re-animation and thyroidectomy, I am only requesting information on procedures that fall under the remit of oculoplastic procedures (though these may sometimes be carried out by plastic surgeons).

I would be grateful if you could complete the attached tables to ensure complete clarity of understanding, though I would also like to receive copies of any relevant policies in full if available, please.

As required by the Freedom of Information Act, I look forward to receiving your response within the statutory 20-working-day period. If there is a need for an extension, please provide the reason for the delay and an estimated timeline for the information's provision.

Our Response

The North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) does not hold the records which you have sought. However, we have determined the records are held by Acute Hospital NHS Foundation Trusts within the North East and North Cumbria region.
