

# How schools are using Mini Scrubs

## Getting creative with careers

Children learned about the roles within the Mini Scrubs booklet and then drew images on a hat to reflect the career they were interested in.

They then took part in a parade, and children and teachers had fun guessing the career displayed on each hat.

## Exploring all roles

Just like in a school where there are many different jobs, children thought about all of the different roles there might be in the local hospital that they could see from their classroom window.

The Mini Scrubs uniforms were spread out across the classroom tables.

The class talked about the different and less well known but important jobs that were needed in a hospital.

## Whole school approach

Children of all ages took part in a Mini Scrubs inspired careers programme across the school.

For older children, teachers used the Mini Scrubs booklet and turned it into factsheets and tasked children with using independent research skills to find out more about different roles.
