Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB)

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 10 February 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

For information Clinical Commissioning Groups ceased to exist on 30 June 2022. Services that were previously delivered by the CCG are now being delivered by the successor organisation NHS North East and North Cumbria (ICB). This covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

Details of Request

1. On the 1st January, how many people from your ICS area who had been referred to an NHS memory service had not yet had an attended first contact? Please can this number be provided for the years 2021, 2022 and 2023, and broken down by the following waiting times between their referral date and 1st January in the given year:
 - a) 6 weeks or less
 - b) greater than 6 weeks and less than or equal to 3 months
 - c) greater than 3 months and less than or equal to 6 months
 - d) greater 6 months and less than or equal to 12 months
 - e) greater than 12 months and less than or equal to 18 months
 - f) greater than 18 months and less than or equal to 24 months
 - g) greater than 24 months
