<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)</u>

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 19 April 2023 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

NENC ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland and Tees Valley.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am requesting the following information on waiting times for ADHD assessments in England:

- 1. The number of undiagnosed children (under the age of 18) currently on the waiting list for an ADHD assessment on the NHS.
 - 1a. Please can you also provide the same information for each of the past five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit.
- The current average waiting time for an undiagnosed child (under the age of 18) to see a psychiatrist for ADHD assessment after being referred from a GP on the NHS.
 - 2a. The longest waiting time for a child currently on the list.

- 2b. Please can you also provide the average wait time for each of the past five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit.
- 3. How many child assessments were done in the past year. Please provide the total and (if available) a breakdown by gender.3a. Please can you also provide this same information for each of the prior five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit.
- 4. The current average waiting time for a child (under the age of 18) between ADHD diagnosis and starting treatment on the NHS. Please provide the total and (if available) a breakdown by type of treatment (medication or behavioural therapy) 4a. The longest waiting time between diagnosis and treatment for a child currently on the list.
 - 4b. Please can you also provide the average wait time for each of the past five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit.
- 5. The number of undiagnosed adults currently on the waiting list for an ADHD assessment on the NHS.
 - 5a. Please can you also provide the same information for each of the past five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit
- 6. The current average wait time for an undiagnosed adult to see a psychiatrist for ADHD after being referred from a GP on the NHS.6a. The longest waiting time for an adult currently on the list6b. Please can you also provide the average wait time for each of the past five
 - 6b. Please can you also provide the average wait time for each of the past five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit.
- 7. How many adult assessments were done in the past year. Please provide the total and (if available) a breakdown by gender.7a. Please can you also provide this same information for each of the prior five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit.
- 8. The current average waiting time for an adult between ADHD diagnosis and starting treatment on the NHS. Please provide the total and (if available) a breakdown by type of treatment (medication or behavioural therapy)
 8a. The longest waiting time between diagnosis and treatment for an adult currently on the list.
 8b. Please can you also provide the average wait time for each of the past fit
 - 8b. Please can you also provide the average wait time for each of the past five years, if doing so won't push this request over the cost limit.
