




Our vision for primary care recovery in the North East and North Cumbria



Recovery requires a whole system approach



Cutting bureaucracy between primary and secondary care



Onward Referral

Direct consultant to consultant referral without the need to refer the patient back to the GP



Complete Care

Patients to leave hospital with all required information, e.g. fit notes and discharge letters



Call and Recall

NHS Trusts to establish call/recall systems for patient follow-up tests or appointments



Clear Points of Contact

Establish single routes for general practice and secondary care teams to communicate rapidly

- √ Matrix working established within ICB
- ✓ Review of acute contracts
- ✓ Single policy under development for ICB implementation
- ✓ Programme of work to implement ICB wide Primary / Secondary Care interface forum
- ✓ Develop pathways with patient at the centre
- √ Co-design in partnership


