Social media toolkit

The toolkit below contains social media resources for a pilot scheme running across the region which allows community pharmacies to manage and treat uncomplicated lower Urinary Tract Infections (UTI) in women aged 16-64 in the North East and North Cumbria.

Introduction and background

A UTI is an infection of any part of the urinary tract.

UTIs are the most common bacterial infection in humans, mainly presenting in women, with 40% of women expected to suffer from one during their lifetime.

Symptoms of a UTI include:

- Burning or stinging sensation on passing urine
- Needing to pass urine frequently or urgently
- Cloudy urine
- Passing excessive or large quantities of urine

More than 75,000 women in the North East and North Cumbria, aged between 16-64, presented at a GP practice with a UTI in the last six months.

UTIs consequently take up a large proportion of resources within the healthcare system, accounting for 2-4% of all GP appointments each year and 10% of extended access appointments are for the treatment of a UTI.

Approx. 15% (4.8 million) of women in the UK suffer from a UTI each year, therefore it is anticipated that high uptake of this service has the potential to significantly reduce demand on general practice, extended access, NHS 111 and urgent and emergency care centres.

The North East and North Cumbria is the 6th highest prescriber of antibiotics for UTIs in England, has the highest rate of admissions for UTIs (which is increasing, unlike the national picture), and is the 3rd highest for female community onset cases of E. coli bacteraemia.

Pilot Scheme

The six-month pilot model in our region will allow female patients age 16-64, with an uncomplicated UTI, to self-present at participating community pharmacies. They can also be referred by their GP Practice through the Community Pharmacist Consultation Scheme for advice and or appropriate treatment from trained community pharmacists.

This service has been approved with the intention of:

- Reducing pressure on general practice, extended access, NHS 111 and urgent and emergency care services (with the aim of 50%+ less GP appointments related to UTIs)
- Providing faster access to treatment and advice where required, to reduce the risk of E.coli bacteraemia and hospital admissions
- Ensure a robust diagnosis, treatment, follow up and evaluation to ensure treatments are being prescribed appropriately



Communications approach

Our campaign aims to

- Raise awareness with women aged 16-64 of the symptoms of uncomplicated UTIs
- Encourage women aged 16-64 with an uncomplicated UTI to go to a participating community pharmacy for timely consultation, advice
 and prescriptions rather than their general practice therefore supporting the aims of the project to reduce GP appointments, antibiotic
 prescribing and hospital admissions.

The pilot will run from now until the end of December 2022.

Communication assets

The campaign will use social media to support communications across the system alongside press releases and possible earned media coverage – animation /posters will be available in toolkit for GP practices and Pharmacies.

Key Messages:

- 1 in 2 women experience a UTI in their lifetime
- More than 75,000 women in the North East and North Cumbria, aged 16-64, presented at a GP practice with a UTI in the last six months.
- Symptoms include burning sensation when weeing, needing to wee frequently or urgently or having cloudy wee
- No need for a GP appointment for a UTI North East & North Cumbria community pharmacies can now provide immediate advice & appropriate treatment for UTIs with no appointment required.
