**Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information – NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)**

Thank you for your request received on 19 December 2025 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Newcastle Gateshead, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley.

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

**Your Request**

Please could you provide me with the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The ICB's total spend on the following areas of care for each of the financial years 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25:

- Hospice care (for both children and adults)

- Community Health services – Children's health services
- Community Health services – Community Speech and Language Therapy
- Community Health services – Falls prevention services
- Community Health services – School health services
- Community Health services – Sexual health services

- Community Health services – Sexual health services

## Our Response

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB holds some of the information you have requested.

### Hospice Care

With regards to hospice care, the ICB's total spend is as follows:

2022/23	£15.545m
2023/24	£15.964m
2024/25	£18.209m

Please note the figures show actual payments made for hospice care to providers in those financial years and may not necessarily be for the financial year in question. The budgeted amount for 2025/26 for NENC ICB was £20.432m.

### Community Health Services

Costs for District Nursing, Children's Health Services, Community Speech and Language Therapy and Falls Prevention are wrapped up within larger block contract arrangements with local Foundation Trusts, and as such the ICB cannot provide spend and budgets for these areas.

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB on this occasion is not able to provide the requested information for School Health and Sexual Health Services. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm the ICB does not hold any of the information requested. These services are commissioned by Local Authorities and/or Public Health.
